Do the outlets look different in your country? You'll need a power plug adapter. Type A - Mostly used in the US,Canada,Mexico,Central America,China and Japan.

However,it is possible you'll need an adapter to plug the charger into a Bangkok outlet. Bangkok uses electrical outlets and power plugs of types A,B,C &O (see images). If your country uses the same electrical outlets and power plugs,you don't need a travel adapter. Are the electrical outlets and power plugs in your country different?

What type of plugs do they use in Bangkok?

In Bangkok,they use Type A,B,C,and O power plugs and outlets. Type A outlets have two flat prongs and no grounding pin. Type B outlets have two flat prongs and a grounding pin. Type A plugs will also fit. Type C outlets have two round prongs and no grounding pin. Type E and F plugs usually fit too,but grounded plugs will need an adapter.
